



REGISTRATION FEES AND POLICIES

July 17-21, 2017

COST FOR MISSISSIPPI STUDENTS AND ADULTS

Early Discount Registration Fee (Feb. 1 – March 1)

\$215 (includes \$50 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit required at registration)

Registration Fee (March 2 – UNTIL CAMP REACHES CAPACITY)

\$265 (includes \$50 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit required at registration)

All out of state registrations are charged an additional \$50 out of state fee
A \$25 cancellation/change fee is charged for each cancellation or change in
addition to forfeiting original registration deposit.

***For billing purposes, the date we receive your completed Registrant's Form (from online registration) is the date recorded as "date registered".**

Registrations will be accepted until Super Summer reaches capacity. Churches unable to get in will be placed on a waiting list. **Balance must be paid by June 1, 2017.**

Students' Medical Forms MUST BE NOTARIZED!!!! These will be turned in at registration.

(Adults are required to complete a medical form)

All students must have two reference forms turned in to group leader, who will turn them in at registration.

ADULT SPONSORS: Each church must send one adult of the same sex (21 years or older) for each 10 youth attending. Team leaders from your church may be considered an adult if they are 21 or older. Students cannot be paired up with another church unless they have registered with that church. No exceptions. The adult will participate in the Kappa Plaid Adult School.

Plaid School provides youth ministry leadership training and encouragement for youth ministers, youth workers, parents, and lay leaders.
